- Clearly tagged/labelled with your full name and contact information (sponsors details).
- Clearly tagged/labelled with a description of the item.
- Clearly tagged/labelled with the value of the item.

You may drop off your item as follows;

- Sunday 21st at the General assembly with Exbo member, Maricar Donato (for Delegates only).
- Monday 22nd at the WFTGA desk located on the 1st floor in the exhibition area. The desk will be open 13:00 – 16:00.

The auction will take place at the Gala dinner on Thursday 25th January.

- A limited number of items will be up for auction and will be selected based on value and interest.
- The auction items will only be handed over to the highest bidder once the money has been received and will need to be collected during the lunch break on Friday 26th.
- All auction items are to be clearly tagged/labelled.



WFTGA Raffle draw

The raffle draws will take place on Friday 26th during the closing ceremony.

A raffle ticket awards a randomly chosen prize from the items donated/sponsored by members and participants.

- Tickets for the raffle are available to purchase at the WFTGA desk on the 1st floor from Monday to Thursday.
- The actual ticket must be presented on Friday during the draw in order to claim your prize.
- WFTGA will not be held responsible for lost tickets.
- 3 tickets for 10.00 euro (cash only) (receipts on request)

- Auction items are well received when they are unique and different. Such items have included jewellery, artworks, tours/travel and so forth.
- Raffle items are unique in that they are items from a country that some participants may not have visited.
